	IGCSE or GCE O-Level: Successful completion of the exam with a minimum grade of C or better in either English as a First or Second Language
	International Baccalaureate: Higher Level (HL) score 3 or higher or Standard Level (SL) score of 5 or higher
Colleges and Universities	International students whose native language is not English must have completed an English Composition course with a grade of C or better
