## Listening

Identify frequently used words, phrases and questions in familiar contexts.

- 1. Use contextual clues to get information from increasingly extended announcements or conversations.
- 2. Interpret face-to-face conversations in familiar contexts.

## Speaking

Demonstrate the ability to communicate basic survival needs and frequent activities in social contexts.

- 1. Discuss familiar topics in conversational exchanges using mostly learned phrases.
- 2. Relate simple personal and/or emergency information.
- 3. Produce and respond to simple questions related to basic needs using previously learned phrases or simple sentences.
