Who should enroll?

Students interested in the available classes can enroll and also access the FREE tutoring, library, and other support services available to all **MiraCosta College** students.

What is the cost of Dual Enrollment?

Courses, textbooks, and materials are *FREE* to Dual Enrollment students.

Is there an additional test or requirements to earn credit, like AP classes?

Students earn the college credit as long as they pass the course with a C or higher. There is no additional test a student has to take outside of the college coursework.
